By identifying goals, we can work on the essential skills that blind and low vision children need to become active participating members of society.

Accommodations for out-of-town guests are secure dormitory suites. Each unit has 2 bedrooms, each with a double bed, shared kitchen and shared bathroom. There will be security staff on duty throughout the weekend.

All meals and snack will be provided. No Alcohol is permitted on campus. We will supply a packed picnic lunch for your family on Sunday to enjoy on the drive home.

Child care is provided during the adult workshops and discussion groups. Brothers and sisters are welcome to attend children's and teens' programming. Evening programs will be fun for the whole family and provide opportunities for social networking. Teen Drop-in Center will be available during the evening.
