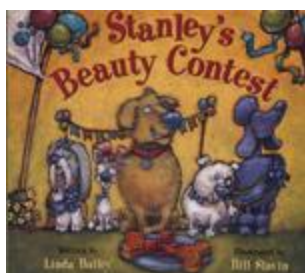

The Blue Spruce Reading Program

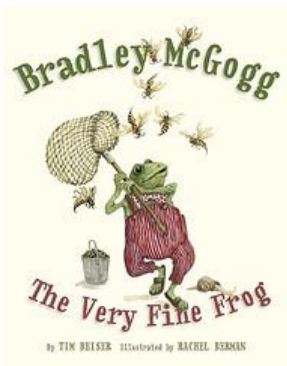

by Linda Bailey

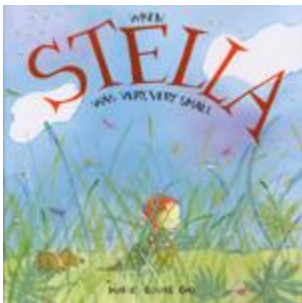
Stanley is back again, and this time he is in a beauty contest! Can he win the ultimate prize—a delicious dog biscuit?

by Tim Beiser

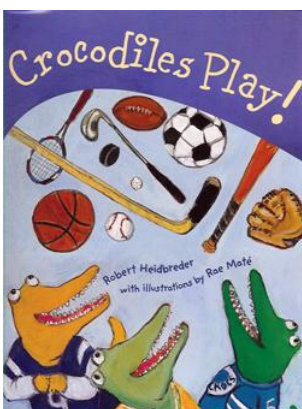
Bradley is a hungry frog looking for lunch, and quickly learns that not all animals eat alike!

by Marie Louise Gay

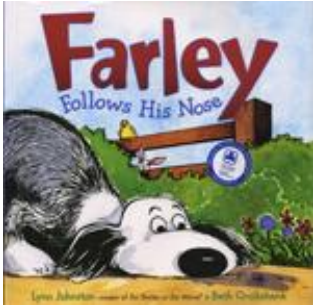
In this magical story, Stella shows us how the world can change with a bit of imagination.

by Robert Heidbreder

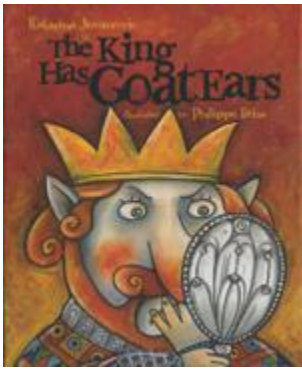
Can crocodiles play sports? In this funny book they can, but their rules are a little bit different than ours!

by Katarina Jovanovic

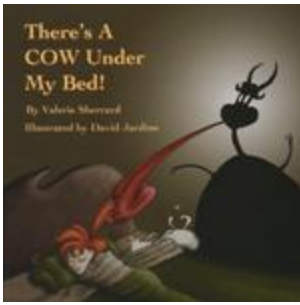
The King has kept his goat ears a secret for a long time, but secrets have a way of getting out!

by Kenneth Oppel

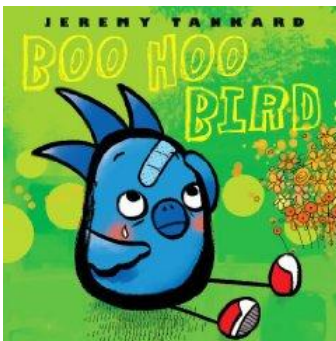
Max is the cook's dog, and he loves all of the cook's food—who wouldn't? The new king, that's who! Can they find a royal recipe to satisfy him in time?

by Valerie Sherrard

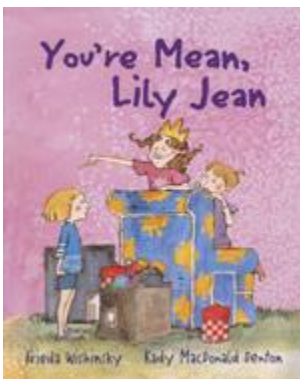
Strange things are happening to Oscar—a cow licks his head each night, there are ants in his pants, and a frog is in his throat!
